How can I align a pedagogy of care with educational reform and especially with social justice and equity in early education?

How can I remove gender stereotypes that restrict care?

How can I free care from associations with weakness or fragility and align care with our power and strength?

How can I position care as a human right and public good?

How can I rescue care? How can care rescue me?

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
